The plan is in its infancy, but the vision is clear: a built-for-purpose unit to take the hospice far into the future, providing flexibility and supporting choice for patients.

The character and age of our main building on London Road undoubtedly help us to create our wonderful home-from-home setting. However, they also create challenges for our staff, such as the layout and the size of the lift.

We are committed to providing care of the highest quality and with this in mind Beaumont House Hospice has been considering various options over recent years to ensure we can continue to offer such services well into the future.

We are thrilled to announce that we are planning to develop a bungalow plot which the charity owns next to the hospice on Lime Grove.

This option will mean little or no interruption to our care.

Head of Clinical Care at Beaumont House, Louise Sinclair, says

**“Upgrading our in-patient unit to a ground floor location on the hospice site will provide a wonderful space for patients and families needing hospice care”.**

We are so pleased that some of the challenges the current unit poses will be improved, increasing access and meaning we can help more local people.”

The project is expected to take two to three years to complete and marks another exciting milestone for Beaumont House Hospice.

Beaumont House Chief Executive, Heidi Hawkins, says,

“we are at the very beginning of this project, and it will require much time and careful planning.

In the meantime, we remain steadfastly committed to ensuring that our range of vital support and care for the people of Newark and Sherwood who need us continues.


# Thank you to our Starlight Striders
