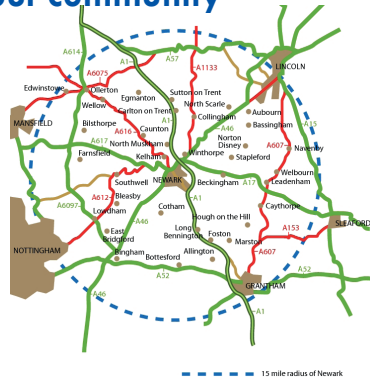

Day Therapy

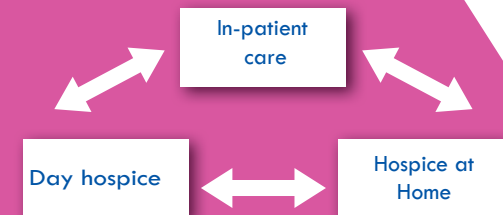
- A happy, caring and supportive environment with lots of laughter
